We are in receipt of your June 13, 2010 letter, which requests a meeting to discuss the notices the Colorado River Indian Tribes recently provided to certain individuals occupying tribal lands without the Tribes' permission. As we have explained to you on several occasions, the Tribe has no interest in meeting with your organization. We do not believe that such a meeting would be useful. However, we are more than willing to meet with any individual member of your organization who would like to come into compliance with the terms of his or her lease or would like to enter a new lease with the Tribes.
